



## Afternoons at River School

The mission of River School is to provide the highest quality care, while creating a nurturing and supportive community of children, parents, and highly skilled staff. Through a play-based program that attends to the whole child, we seek to enrich every child's experience, and to empower each child to joyfully develop at his or her own rate. We provide a strong foundation of community, while developing creative expression and nurturing a passion for learning. Our students gain a deep understanding of themselves and are inspired to act with compassion and integrity.

Afternoons at River School are designed to complement the Yarmouth Public Pre-K Morning Program. Bus service will be provided from Rowe School at the dismissal time of 11:25a.m. and arrive at River School just minutes later. Your child will receive a warm welcome at the bus and be escorted into the school where they will join the other children staying for our full day pre-k program. Once they have settled in, they will enjoy lunch followed by a brief circle time to connect, and then restful yoga. The remainder of the afternoon will be filled with dramatic play, art projects both 2-D and 3-D, baking, as well as outdoor play in River's outdoor spaces and Royal River Park.

We follow the Yarmouth School Department calendar, so we observe the same holidays and school vacations.
